

Pearl Lam Galleries is delighted to present *Labyrinth(s)*, featuring works by eight contemporary artists: Leonardo Drew, Golnaz Fathi, Gonkar Gyatso, Ni Haifeng, Peter Peri, Kour Pour, Gatot Pujiarto, and Ben Quilty. The title of the exhibition references Jorge Luis Borges's celebrated short story "The Garden of Forking Paths".

In Borges' story, the protagonist Dr. Yu Tsun muses about a lost labyrinth:

I imagined it inviolate and perfect at the secret crest of a mountain; I imagined it erased by rice fields or beneath the water; I imagined it infinite, no longer composed of octagonal kiosks and returning paths, but of rivers and provinces and kingdoms...I thought of a labyrinth of labyrinths, of one sinuous spreading labyrinth that would encompass the past and the future and in some way involve the stars. Absorbed in these illusory images, I forgot my destiny of one pursued.

By investigating the associative potential of their chosen media and forming metaphorical labyrinths with diverse artistic languages that offer unlimited alternatives, the artists in this exhibition examine the notion of infiniteness. The use of different media in turn constructs a huge labyrinth. Audiences can decide for themselves what the artworks really are: paintings, sculptures, photographs, installations, or hybrid fusions. Meanwhile, different artists build up the labyrinth into different universes in specific gradations. They investigate the inner labyrinths of materials, connections between figuration and abstraction, politics of identity, religion, and popculture, and indulge the viewers in a visual sublime.

With the exploration of René Guénon's explanation of Eastern and Western traditions, British artist Peter Peri (b. 1971) shifts the complex representations of humans and heaven into symbols and the use of

lines as informed by Taoist thinking in his marker pen and spray paint on linen works.

The woodblock pieces by 29-year-old Los Angeles-based British-Iranian artist Kour Pour (b. 1987) are informed by Western abstract tradition and Japanese aesthetics. They are actually a translation of earthquake and volcano maps produced by the Japanese Geological Survey, referring to the shifting and overlapping of different aesthetics with this physical metaphor of transformation. Celebrating the craftsmanship of carpets in different cultures, where decorative motifs trace back cultural histories, *Shaolin Mural (Fragments)*, a piece from Pour's carpet painting series, consists of different cultural patterns such as the Chinese Buddha and decorations, Persian horses, Egyptian gods and figures, as well as Japanese characters.

Interested in post-colonialism and cultural exchange, Chinese artist Ni Haifeng (b. 1964) makes written marks on top of bodies, objects, and environments. Ni states his intention, "The self is examined at various specific temporal/spatial coordinates and can therefore be seen as a cue to the broader historical realities." *The Warehouse* (1988) is a series of photographs from the late 1980s that conveys our desire to project personal memories onto a physical origin that is always subject to change. Ni's photograph *Self-Portrait as Part of the Porcelain Export History* (1999–2001) addresses the way in which colonial history has infringed onto our bodies in the name of otherness, an issue central to the discussion of identity politics during the 1990s.

Influenced by abstract expressionism, American artist Leonardo Drew's (b. 1961) work places an emphasis on concept, materiality, and process. He asserts the physical characteristic of his materials, emphasising their texture, colour, and shape, to

create something that is insistently sculptural. The connectivity between humanity and the physical existences is projected from his wooden lines and paper, giving his artwork lives of their own.

Emphasising an infinite series of lines—a growing, dizzying net of divergent, convergent, and parallel lines—Iranian artist Golnaz Fathi's (b. 1972) works are influenced by traditional Persian calligraphy, but are entirely modern. She practices drawing the lines on paper every day until the paper is covered with black ink. Despite the fact that writing is a significant element in her works, Fathi does not aim to present the existing aesthetic value and form of traditional calligraphy, but instead unites these values and forms with images that can be appreciated in the contemporary world.

The artworks by Gonkar Gyatso, Gatot Pujiarto, and Ben Quilty contain subtle iconography and symbolism. Quilty's investigations surround the issue of masculinity. His works relate to his own past, as well as Australia's wider historical culture. The Photojournalist (AQ) (2014) is a portrait of Quilty's cousin, photojournalist Andrew Quilty, who spends his time displaced in countries like Syria and Afghanistan. The work refers to the relationship between identity and current affairs. Gonkar Gyatso's Buddha sculptures are covered with stickers that reference pop culture, indicating how cultural globalisation has affected traditional Buddhism. The works can be seen as the artist's own meditation on what it means to be living in a particular place at a particular time. Gyatso inserts Buddhist and Tibetan iconography into our daily lives. Gatot Pujiarto's works are narrative and figurative. The works are influenced by his daily experiences and surrounding occurrences, and they preserve his memories.

藝術門(畢打行)榮幸呈獻群展《迷宮》,展出八位當代藝術家的作品,分別為萊昂納多·德魯(Leonardo Drew)、賈奈絲·法蒂(Golnaz Fathi)、賈嘎嘉措、倪海峰、彼得·佩里(Peter Peri)、庫爾·珀爾(Kour Pour)、嘉多特·布吉爾多(Gatot Pujiarto)以及本·奎爾蒂(Ben Quilty)。展覽標題引用自豪爾赫·路易斯·博爾赫斯(Jorge Luis Borges)的著名短篇小說《歧路花園》。

在博爾赫斯的小說裡,主角余準對一個消失的迷 宮展開沉思:

"我想象它在一座秘密的山峰上,完好無損地保存著;我想象它被稻田覆蓋,或者沉没在海底;我想象它廣闊無比,不僅有八角涼亭和曲徑通幽,還有許多河流、領域和王國……我想到了一個由迷宫組成的迷宫,一個錯綜複雜、生生不息的迷宮,將過去和未来連在一起,在某種意義上甚至牽涉到別的星球。我沉浸在虚幻的想象中,忘記了自己的處境。"

通過探索相關的媒材,以及運用多樣藝術語言組 建數個無形的迷宮,是次藝術家探討了其對無限 的見解。一個大型的迷宮由此誕生。觀者可以自 己定義所看到的作品:畫作、雕塑、攝影、裝 置,或者混合媒體。同時,不同藝術家各自的迷 宮都是一個獨特的領域。他們共同探索著媒材、 具象與抽象的聯繫、身份政治、宗教,以及流行 文化,每一個主題都可以被看作單獨的迷宮,帶 領觀者進入視覺的頂點。

吸收了勒內·蓋農(René Guénon)對東西方傳統的探索,英國藝術家彼得·佩里(生於1971年)將人類和天堂的複合表達轉述成符號和線條。在道家思想的影響下,這些線條以記號筆、噴漆和帆布為媒介被表現出來。

29歲的英籍伊朗藝術家庫爾·珀爾(生於1987年)現時生活和工作於美國洛杉磯。他的木刻印板作品受到傳統西方抽象主義和日本美學的影響,畫面參考了由日本地理學研究中心提供的地震帶和火山帶地圖,由此表現出不同美學文化在變化的物理形態隱喻之間的轉變與重疊。頌揚地毯在不同文化中的技藝,畫作的裝飾圖案可以追溯至其文化歷史。藝術家的地毯繪畫系列中的《少林壁畫(碎片)》就包含了多樣的文化圖騰,例如中國佛像和裝飾圖案、波斯馬匹、埃及天神和傳說人物,以及日本角色。

中國藝術家倪海峰(生於1964年)致力於探索後殖民主義和文化交換的議題,在人體、物件和環

境的表面畫上各種的符號。他曾講述他的意圖: 「自我是在不同特定時間和空間結合的條件下被 審查的,所以可以被看作更為廣闊的歷史事實的 線索。」《倉庫》(1988年)為一系列80年代末 的攝影作品,表達了我們渴望把個人記憶投射到 物質上,而物質總易於改變。《作為瓷器出口歷 史一部分的自畫像》(1999年至2001年)闡述殖 民歷史在我們身上以他者之名侵入,這也是90年 間探討身分政治的主要話題。

受到抽象表現主義的影響,美國藝術家莱昂纳 多·德鲁(生於1961年)的作品強調了其概念、 物質性、以及創作過程。他通過運用媒材的物理 性質,強調其肌理、顏色、以及形狀,創作出雕 塑性的繪畫。人性與其物理存在的關聯在他的木 製作品中得以體現,從而賦予其生命力。

伊朗藝術家貢奈絲·法蒂(生於1972年)的作品 強調線條的無限性——一種擴張的,在分歧中交 匯與平行的線條。她受到波斯傳統書法的影響, 但其作品實則極其現代。她每天的紙本上練習線 條,直至作品上被黑色墨水覆蓋。儘管書法在她 的作品中是很重要的元素,法蒂並不旨在表現傳 統書法的現有美學價值和形式,她反而將其價值 與形式結合圖像,使其在當代語境下得以為人所 欣賞。



LEONARDO DREW

萊昂納多・德魯

Leonardo Drew was born in 1961 in Tallahassee, Florida and grew up in Bridgeport, Connecticut. Drew seemed bound to work as a professional artist from a young age; his works were exhibited publically for the first time when he was only 13 years old. By the age of 15, DC and Marvel Comics courted him to work as an illustrator. However, Drew would apply his talents to a very different artistic path; the abstract works of Jackson Pollock and Piet Mondrian greatly inspired him. Drew went on to attend the Parsons School of Design in New York and earned his Bachelor of Fine Arts from Cooper Union in 1985.

Drew's works are always sculptural, although he tends to avoid making freestanding pieces. Instead, he will often mount objects onto panels or directly to the wall, which can be seen as a nod to his beginnings as a painter and draftsman. His seminal work *Number 8* features rope, animal hide, raccoon skull, and even a dead bird that all hang together, all painted black, creating a deep, dark, and brooding sculptural take on Pollock's all-over drip painting.

Rooted in historical evidence, Leonardo Drew's abstract sculptural compositions are emotionally charged reflections on the cyclical nature of existence—from the eroded fibres of human industry and the urban tide of development to the awareness that we are a part of the fabric of a larger universe. His works reflect the universality of existence and the interconnectivity of all beings to one another. They illustrate these relationships through a combination of the visceral qualities of the materials with the abstract sculptural forms the pieces make up. These cosmological frameworks are meant to mirror the organic reality of existence and reveal the resonance of life and humanity.

Leonardo Drew's work has been exhibited across the United States and internationally. Major solo exhibitions include Vigo Gallery, London, UK (2015); Anthony Meier Fine Arts, San Francisco, USA (2014); Selected Works, SCAD Museum of Art at the Savannah College of Art and Design, Savannah, Georgia, USA (2013); Existed: Leonardo Drew, Blaffer Gallery, Art Museum of the University of Houston, Houston, USA (2009); Palazzo Delle Papesse, Centro Arte Contemporanea, Siena, Italy (2006); Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Smithsonian Institution, Washington, D.C., USA (2000); The Bronx Museum of the Arts, New York, USA (2000); and the Museum of Contemporary Art, San Diego, California, USA (1995).

Major group exhibitions include *Structures of Recollection*, Pearl Lam Galleries, Hong Kong, China (2016); *Unsuspected Possibilities*, SITE Santa Fe, New Mexico, USA (2015); Summer Group Show, Galerie Forsblom, Helsinki, Finland (2014); *Material World*, Denver Art Museum, Denver, Colorado, USA (2013); Museum of Art and Design, New York, USA (2012); *From Then to Now: Masterworks of Contemporary African American Art*, Museum of Contemporary Art Cleveland, Ohio, USA (2010); *Lost and Found: Selections from the MCA Collection*, Museum of Contemporary Art (MCA), Chicago, USA (2010); and *Black Alphabet: Contexts of Contemporary African American Art*, Zacheta National Gallery of Art, Warsaw, Poland (2006).

Leonardo Drew's works are also held internationally in public and private collections, such as with the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York, USA; the Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles, USA; and the Princeton University Art Museum, Princeton, New Jersey, USA.

莱昂纳多·德鲁於1961年在佛羅里達州塔拉哈西市出生,並在康涅狄格州布里奇波特市長大。從小,德鲁就似乎注定會成為一名職業藝術家。年僅十三歲,德鲁便首次對公眾展出了他的作品。到了十五歲,他被DC漫畫公司和漫威漫畫公司特聘為插畫師。然而,天賦異稟的德鲁卻走上了一條非同尋常的藝術道路。抽像藝術賦予他無盡的靈感,尤其是Jackson Pollock和 Piet Mondrian的作品。德鲁曾求學於紐約帕森斯設計學院,並於1985年在紐約庫伯高等藝術聯合學院取得美術學士學位。

德鲁的創作主要為雕塑作品,他傾向於避免創作獨立式的部件, 反將物件嵌入板面或直接鑲在牆上,這樣的創作被視為是對他早 期作為畫家和繪圖師經歷的一個回應。他的重要作品《數字8》 由繩索捆吊在一起的獸皮,浣熊頭骨和鳥屍組成,作品整體被塗 成黑色,以雕塑形式創造出一個深沉、黑暗和不安的氛圍,表達 了德鲁對Pollock滴畫的理解。

以史實作為靈感,藝術家所創造的抽象裝置展示著對存在的循環往復之本質、人類處境以及萬物相連的情感映射——從人類工業留下的腐爛纖維物、城市發展的趨勢到人類自身作為浩瀚宇宙及相聯萬物中一部分的覺醒。作品反映著存在的普遍性和萬物間的關聯性。通過對材質內在特性的組合以及用它們拼湊出抽象雕塑的形式,德鲁用作品闡明箇中關係。貫徹作品的哲學架構反映出現存的事物,展現著生命與人性之間的共鳴。

莱昂纳多·德鲁是一位卓越的藝術家, 他的作品展出於美國 以及世界各地,主要個展包括: Vigo畫廊,英國倫敦 (2015年); 安東尼邁耶美術館,美國三藩市 (2014年); 《精選作品》,薩凡納藝術與設計學院藝術博物館,美國喬治亞州 (2013年); 「生存: 莱昂纳多·德鲁」,侯斯頓大學美術館Blaffer畫廊,美國 侯斯頓 (2009年); 帕佩塞宮當代藝術中心,意大利錫耶納 (2006年); 赫希杭博物館和雕塑園,史密森尼學會,美國華盛頓 (2000年); 布朗克斯藝術博物館,美國紐約 (2000年); 以及聖地亞哥當代美術館,美國加利福尼亞州 (1995年)。

GOLNAZ FATHI 貢奈絲・法蒂

Born in Tehran in 1972, Golnaz Fathi is an influential member of a currently thriving generation of artists to surface in Iran over the last twenty years.

Whilst studying Graphic Design at Azad University, in Tehran, Fathi became fascinated by the expressive potential of traditional Persian calligraphic forms and immersed herself in a sustained six-year study of traditional calligraphy. She became one of only a tiny handful of women trained to the highest level within that discipline. At this point, Fathi made the conscious decision to fulfill her career as an artist rather than to continue within the privileged world of pure Islamic calligraphy, practiced predominantly by male calligraphers.

Fathi investigated ever more abstract forms of representation, using modern media to aid these explorations, whilst still basing her work on fundamental calligraphic practices and techniques. The introduction of bold swatches of colour further emphasised her transition from a codified system based on prescriptive rules to an alternative idiom that gave precedence to her own imaginative modes of subjective expression.

Fathi's works are in the permanent collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York; Brighton & Hove Museum, England; Carnegie Mellon University, Doha; the Islamic Arts Museum Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur; Asian Civilizations Museum, Singapore; British Museum, London; Devi Art Foundation, New Delhi; and The Farjam Collection, Dubai.

Golnaz Fathi has received a number of awards including the Best Woman Calligraphist in Ketabat Style in 1995 by the Iranian Society of Calligraphy in Tehran and was chosen by a jury for the Young Global Leader Honoree in 2011 at the Sharjah Calligraphy Biennale. She has also exhibited in museums and galleries around the world, including in Hong Kong, New York, Paris, New Delhi, China, the United Kingdom, South Korea, Germany, and Switzerland.

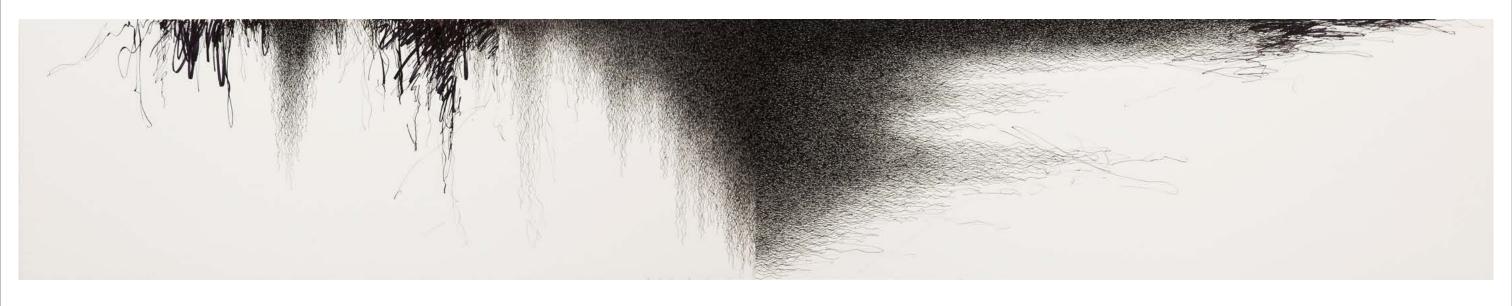
1972年出生於德黑蘭,貢奈絲·法蒂(Golnaz Fathi)是伊朗最具影響力的藝術家之一。她與其他同時代的伊朗藝術家在過去20年中逐漸成長並活躍起來。

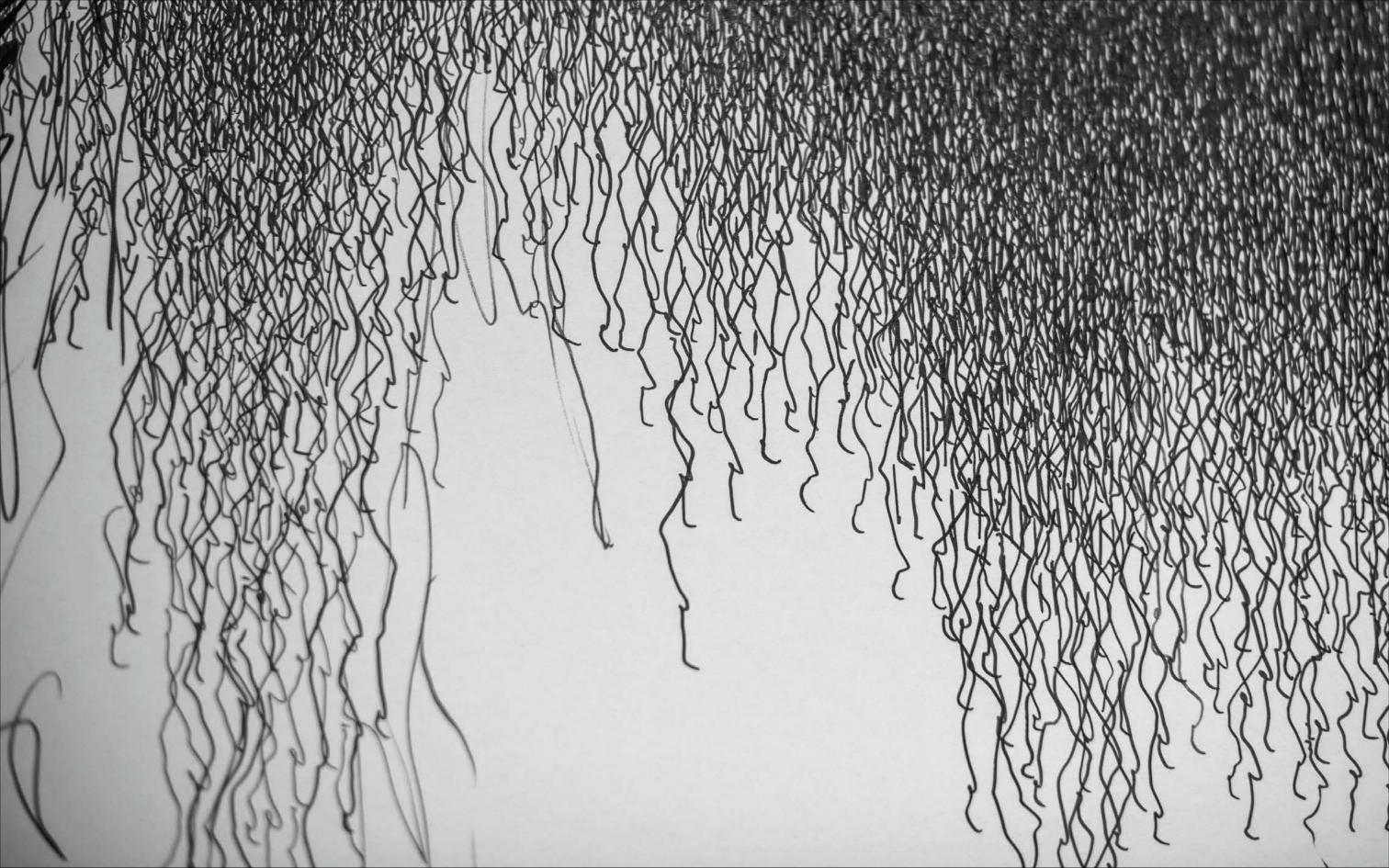
法蒂在德黑蘭阿紮達大學修習圓形設計時, 即被傳統波斯書法的形式表現力深深吸引, 由此開始了長達六年的傳統書法訓練。她是 屈指可數的、在傳統伊朗書法領域獲得最高 成就的女書法家之一。亦在此時,法蒂有意 選擇離開長期被男性主導的伊斯蘭純書法世界,轉而追尋她作為藝術家的事業。

法蒂以現代媒介探索對書法形式的抽象再現, 她的創作亦得益於過去嚴格的書法訓練和技 巧。大膽色塊的引入更強調了其創作理念的改 變,即從固定的、規範化的書寫系統過渡到主 觀的、充滿想象力的藝術表達,在此新領域 中,藝術家的個性和自由占據了優勢。

法蒂作品的公共收藏機構包括: 紐約大都會藝術博物館、英國布萊頓霍夫博物館、倫敦大英博物館,新德里Devi藝術基金會、吉隆坡伊斯蘭藝術博物館、新加坡亞洲文明博物館、多哈Carnegie Mellon大學基金會和杜拜Farjam Collection。

法蒂曾獲得眾多獎項與榮譽,包括: 1995 年由德黑蘭伊朗書法協會頒發的Ketabat女 書法家最佳風格獎、2011年沙迦書法雙年 展全球青年領袖獎項(The Young Global Leader Honoree)等。她的作品在香港、 紐約、巴黎、新德里、中國、聯合王國、韓 國、德國和瑞士等地方的美術館和畫廊廣泛 展出。她現在生活和工作於德黑蘭和巴黎。



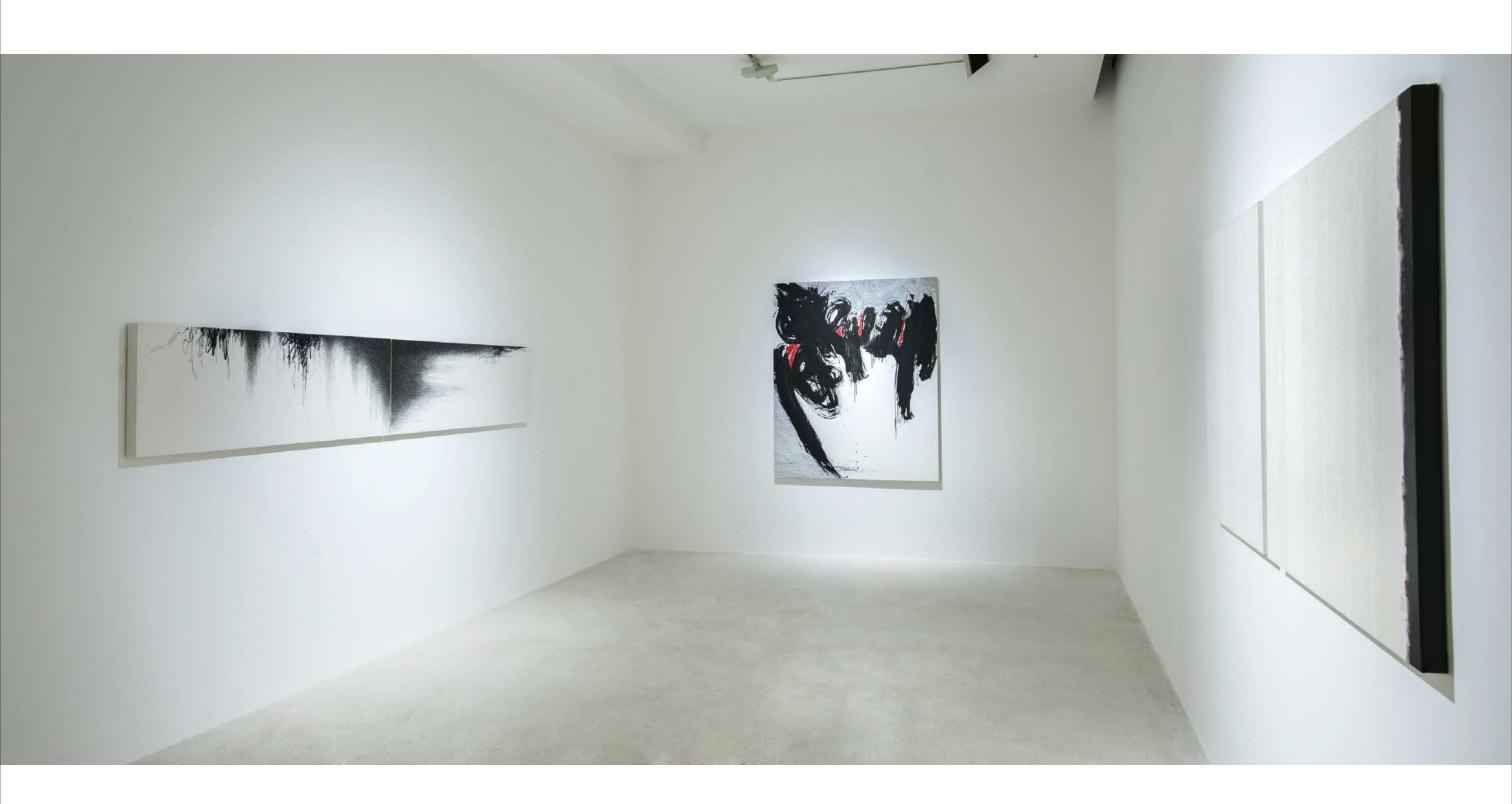

GONKAR GYATSO

貢嘎嘉措

Gonkar Gyatso is a Tibetan-born British artist. Born in 1961 in Lhasa, Gyatso moved to London in the late 90s on a scholarship to study at the Chelsea School of Art and Design, where he attained his MA in Fine Art. Gyatso studied Chinese Brush Painting in Beijing, attaining a BFA. He also studied Thangka painting (traditional Tibetan scroll painting) in Dharamsala. Gyatso is the founder of the Sweet Tea House, a contemporary art gallery dedicated to showing Tibetan work, based in London, which he ran from 2003–10. The artist was the recipient of a Leverhulme Fellowship in 2003 and was an artist in residence at Pitt Rivers Museum in Oxford.

Gonkar Gyatso's work comes out of a fascination with material and pop culture along with a desire to bring equal attention to the mundane as well as the extraordinary, the imminent, and the superfluous. These contradictions are often found in the same piece. His work can be very silly, uncanny, and even ironic and at the same time comes out of concerns that are shaping our times. As his own experience has been one that reflects a kind of hybridity and transformation, his work also holds this quality.

We are all repositories of our time and place; the work cannot help but reveal the politics and cultures that have shaped him. Gyatso collects materials from around the world to construct his images. Each work contains a kind of geographic specificity, relating to the time and place he is making the work, where he has been, and the things that have touched him.

Gyatso's interest in signage and iconography have led him to design his own stickers and signs that he incorporates into his work; sometimes they are collaged in and at others they stand on their own, each representing a social or political trend that he would like to bring to attention. The artist's repeated use of the Buddha and appropriation of our media-saturated environments illustrate his interest in ubiquity and accessibility, often appropriating and even re-appropriating his own work. What once was "white noise" becomes a cacophony of carefully composed images, beautifully constructed into an iconographic form or word.

While graffiti is now considered its own art form, Gyatso is also interested in pushing the boundaries between what some may classify as high and low art and certainly takes a lot of his inspiration from the street.

Gyatso is deeply moved by the need to preserve and celebrate his own culture and just as artists like Judy Chicago seek to make the vernacular of womanhood part of our discourse or Glenn Ligon works to talk about black identity in America or Yinka Shonibare, MBE uses the textiles of his heritage to address issues of colonialism, Gyatso inserts Buddhist and Tibetan iconography into our daily lives. They all ask, where is our place? What is our role? And, where are we going from here? Just as the identity of Gyatso's homeland, Tibet, cannot be separated from religion and politics, the undeniable bond between the two has shaped his own sensibility as well.

Gyatso's work has been exhibited in galleries and museums around the world, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art (New York, USA), the Boston Museum of Fine Arts (Boston, USA), Tel Aviv Museum of Art (Israel), The City Gallery (Wellington, New Zealand), The Institute of Modern Art (Brisbane, Australia), the Rubin Museum of Art (New York, USA), the National Art Museum of China (Beijing, China), the Glasgow Gallery of Modern Art (Scotland), the Courtauld Institute of Art (London, UK), the Wereldmuseum Rotterdam (the Netherlands), and the Queensland Art Gallery and Gallery of Modern Art (Brisbane, Australia). Additionally, he has participated in the 53rd Venice Biennale (Italy), the 6th Asia Pacific Triennial in Brisbane (Australia), and the 17th Sydney Biennale (Australia). His work is held internationally in public and private collections.

頁嘎嘉措是出生於西藏的英籍藝術家。他於1961年出生於拉薩,在90年代末到英國切爾西藝術與設計學院學習,獲得藝術碩士學位。頁嘎嘉措在北京學習過中國水墨畫,並取得了藝術學士學位;在達蘭薩拉(Dharamsala)學習了唐卡(一種西藏傳統捲軸畫)。他是致力於展出西藏藝術的當代畫廊「倫敦甜茶館(Sweet Tea House)」的創始人,並在這裡從2003年工作至2010年。2003年,頁嘎嘉措獲得Leverhelm獎學金,並成為了牛津大學Pitt Rivers Museum的常駐藝術家。

頁嘎嘉措的作品來源於他對物質和流行文化的著迷。他著力於 給予單調與超凡,緊要和渺小同等的注意力。這些矛盾往往在 從一個地方被找到,他的作品可以是很笨拙的,不可思議的, 甚至諷刺的,並與此同時塑造對我們的時代的擔憂。他自身的 經歷反映了一種雜糅和轉換,他的作品也有同樣的品質。

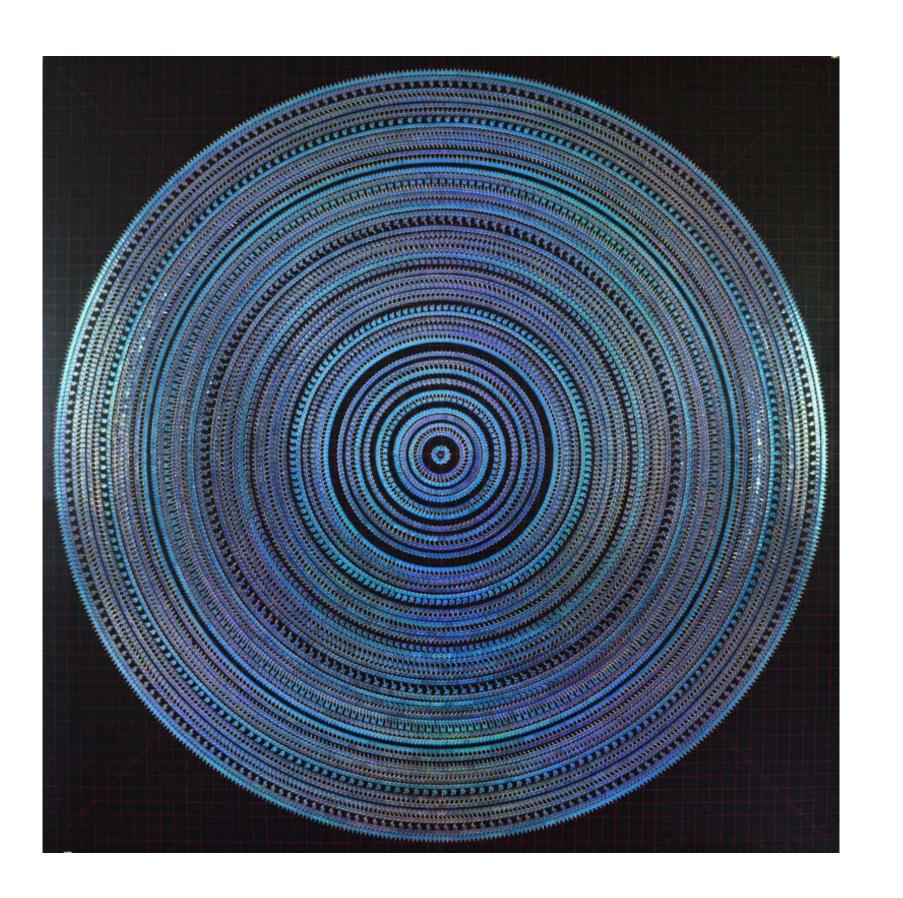
人們是其生活的時代和地點的體現, 貢嘎嘉措的的作品無可避免地揭示了塑造他的政治與文化。 貢嘎加錯從世界各地收集他構造圖像的材料, 其中的每幅作品都包含一種地理的特殊性, 這種特殊性連結著他創作時的時間和空間, 他曾去過的地方和那些感動他的事物。

貢嘎嘉措對於標牌和圖解的興趣引領他設計出自己的貼紙和標識,並將它們融入在自己的作品當中。有時它們被拼貼在一起,另外一些時候它們只是單獨的存在。貢嘎嘉措重複性地使用佛像,和對媒體發達環境的解讀,表達了他對普遍性和可得性的興趣。他也常常重新解讀自己的作品。曾經的「白噪聲」被營造成一種肖像的形式,或是文字的形式,變成了一幅精心構圖的雜音。

雖然塗鴉現在被認為是一種獨特的藝術形式,貢嘎嘉措仍有意挑戰所謂高雅藝術和低俗藝術的邊界,他有很多靈感都來自街頭。

頁嘎嘉措深深地感到存留和歌頌自己文化的重要性。像是Judy Chicago試圖把女性的口吻變成我們的會話,Glenn Ligon討論美國的黑人身份,或是因卡·修尼巴爾(Yinka Shonibare)運用他民族的紡織品探討殖民主義的問題,頁嘎嘉措把佛教和西藏的文化符號嵌入我們的日常生活當中。人人都在問,我們在哪?我們是誰?而我們又從這裡去往何處?頁嘎嘉措的家鄉西藏是無法拋開與宗教和政治的影響而獨立看待的,這兩者不可否認的連結也塑造了他本人的感性。

他的作品曾在世界知名的畫廊和博物館展出過,包括:美國紐約 大都會藝術博物館,美國波士頓美術館,以色列特拉維夫藝術博 物館,新西蘭惠靈頓城市畫廊,澳洲現代藝術學院,美國紐約魯 賓藝術博物館,中國北京國家美術館,蘇格蘭格拉斯哥當代藝術 館,英國倫敦科陶德藝術學院,瑞士Burger Collection,荷蘭鹿 特丹博物館,以及澳洲昆士蘭美術館與現代藝術博物館。此外他 還參加了第五十三屆威尼斯雙年展,位於布里斯班的第六屆亞太 三年站,和第十七屆悉尼雙年展。他的作品不僅多次在國內外展 出,也同樣被公共場館與私人予以收藏。

NI HAIFENG 倪海峰

Ni Haifeng was born in 1964 in Zhoushan, China. In 1986, he graduated from Zhejiang Academy of Fine Arts, now the China Academy of Art. He currently lives and works between Amsterdam and Beijing.

Ni Haifeng's practice draws from an interest in cultural systems of exchange, return, language, and production. Through photography, video and installation, he explores the simultaneous creation and obliteration of meaning while drawing attention to the cyclical movements of people, products, and goods that are often reflective of patterns of colonialism and globalisation. Aims to subvert the status quo and counteract preconceived notions of art are, in Ni's words, an effort towards reaching a "zero degree of meaning". The concept of uselessness, seen in the desire to offset "the production of the useful" that is central to the operative conditions of consumerism and the "dominant economic order", plays a key role within Ni's practice, lending his works a distinct political and social dimension.

After graduating from the Zhejiang Academy of Fine Arts in 1986, Ni joined RED 70%, BLACK 25%, WHITE 5%, a group of artists working with conceptual art and nonsense text. These early works focused on acts of writing, re-appropriations and deconstructed forms of language. Since the mid-1990s, after emigrating to Europe, his work has acquired additional layers that refer to his new identity as a Chinese immigrant, and to issues of (post-)colonialism and "otherness". For example, Ni created a series of installations that featured objects and tableaux suspended from knotted ropes. Precariousness and instability are dominant factors in these works, as is the persistent sense of weight, balance, and a feeling of danger elicited in the viewer. In recent years, overt and covert references to manufacturing and production have formed recurring themes within Ni's artistic practice.

Ni Haifeng's work has been exhibited throughout Asia and Europe in selected solo exhibitions, including Asynchronous, Parallel, Tautological, et cetera... (2015), Pearl Lam Galleries, Hong Kong, China; Project for Ignatius (2012), St. Ignatius Gymnasium, Amsterdam, the Netherlands (Public work); Vive la Difference (2010), Gallery Lumen Travo, Amsterdam, the Netherlands: Of the Departure and the Arrival (2009). Teemtower, Guangzhou: Para-Production (2008), Joy Art, Beijing; The Return of the Shreds (in collaboration with Kitty Zijlmans) (2007), Stedelijk Museum De Lakenhal in Scheltema, Leiden, the Netherlands; and Ni Haifeng: Xeno-Writings (2004), Museum Het Domein, Sittard, the Netherlands. Selected group shows include Dai Hanzi: 5000 Artists (2014), Witte de With, Center for Contemporary Art, Rotterdam, the Netherlands; Manifesta 9-The Deep of the Modern (2012), Waterscai, Genk, Belgium; Silent Writings (2009), Espace Culturel Louis Vuitton, Paris, France; and Begegnung mit den Anderen (Encounter with Others) (1992), K18, Kassel, Germany. His works have been collected by the M+ in the West Kowloon Cultural District in Hong Kong, China; Guangdong Museum of Art in Guangzhou, China; Museum Huis Marseille in Amsterdam, the Netherlands; Museum De Lakenhal in Lakenhal, the Netherlands; Queensland Art Gallery in Brisbane, Australia; and other public collections.

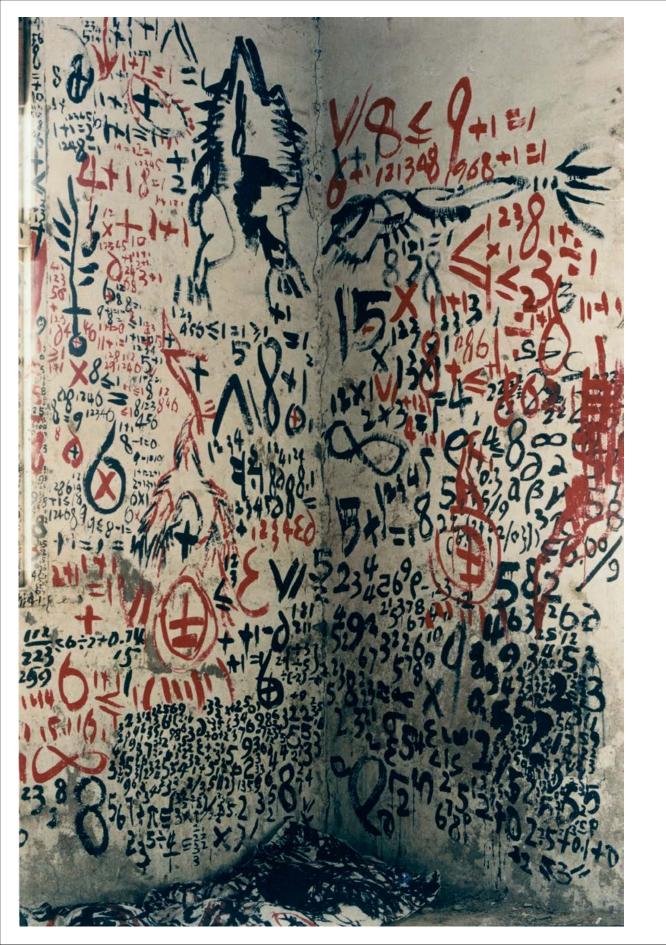
倪海峰的藝術實踐來自於對文化體系中的互換、回歸、語言和生產的關注。透過攝影、錄像及裝置創作,他探討同時存在於意義中的創造與消亡,並著眼於反映著殖民主義和全球化模式的人、產品及商品之間的循環變動。

1986年從浙江美院畢業後,倪海峰加入了「紅70%,黑25%,白5%」——一個致力於概念藝術和無意義文本創作的藝術團體。這些早期作品強調寫作、再挪用以及語言的解構。九十年代中移居歐洲後,倪海峰成了一名中國移民。因為這個新身份,他的作品多了一重層次,並開始提及(後)殖民主義和"差異性"。倪海峰創作了一系列的裝置藝術作品,包括被纏結繩索懸掛的物件和繪畫作品。不穩定性和偶然性成了重些作品中的主導因素,同樣的因素還有持續不斷的生現區、平衡感和從觀者中引發的危機感。近年來,在倪海峰的藝術實踐中,對製造與生產業明顯而又隱晦的呈現再次成為了他的作品主題。

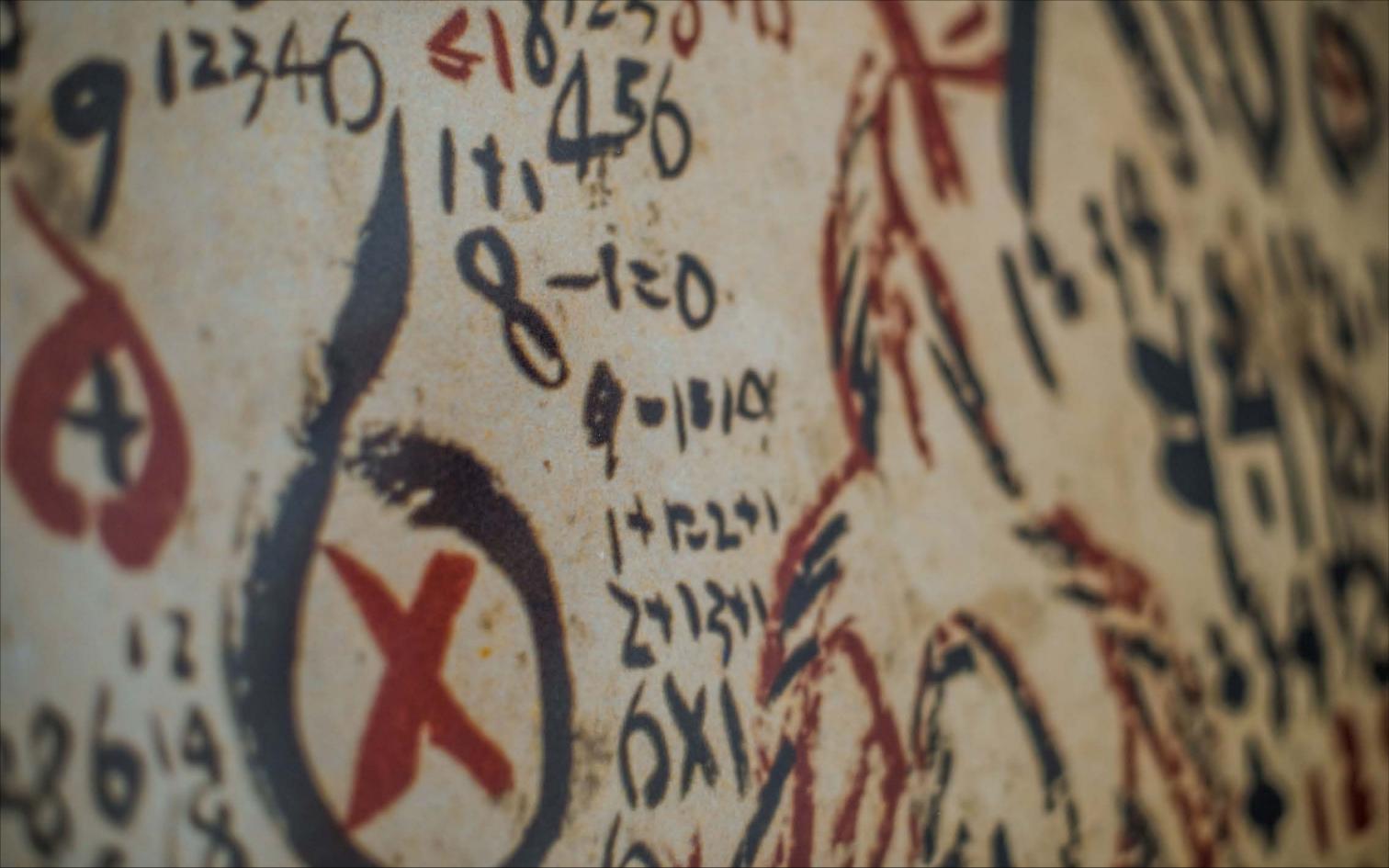

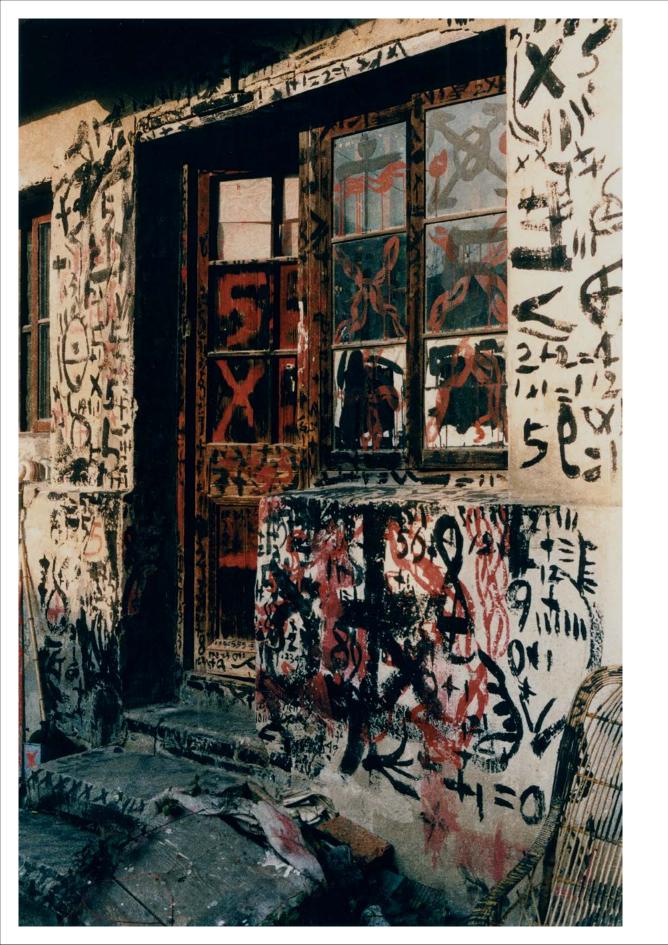

PETER PERI 彼得・佩里

Peter Peri was born in 1971 in London, UK. He received his BA (Hons) in Design from the Central Saint Martins School of Art and Design, London in 1994, and he graduated from the MA Fine Art programme at Chelsea College of Art and Design, London in 2003. Peri currently lives and works in London, UK.

Peri's primary media are drawing, sculpture, and painting: three distinct bodies of work that are developed independently by the artist to create a complex set of interrelations. All works are specifically invested in the tension between line and volume, figuration and abstraction, and in the question of tradition and influence in Modernism.

His drawings are built-up through the accumulation of tiny hair-like pencil lines that lend an obsessive, congested quality to his strict forms and figures. Peri's works on paper depict a range of subject matter, including Roman Catholic reliquaries, abstract portraits, and geometric shapes, which coalesce into ambiguous architectural structures and volumes through an uncanny play of light and shadow redolent of Metaphysical painting.

The sculptures are engineered replicas in darkened steel of ephemeral assemblages of household boxes scaled up in size to create monumental and confrontational cuboid figures. The rolls of masking tape used to construct the original assemblages often functioning as absurd hollow "heads".

Peri's striated monochrome paintings are characterised by their hard-edged diagonal networks of fine silver and pastel-coloured marker pen lines against blackened and gnarled spray-painted backgrounds. These paintings appear to trace an occult tinged geometric language—a Morse code of shifting lines and shapes—that might be used to describe the world in more elemental terms.

Peter Peri's recent and major solo exhibitions include *Filler* (2015), Budapest Art Factory, Hungary; *The Reign of Quantity* (2014), Pearl Lam Galleries, Singapore; Cass Sculpture Foundation, West Sussex, UK (2014); *Last Family* (2013), Almine Rech Gallery, Brussels, Belgium; *We, The Children of the 20th Century* (2011), Almine Rech Gallery, Paris, France; *Peter Peri* (2011), Bortolami Gallery, New York, USA (2010); and *ART NOW* (2007), Tate Britain, London, UK. His works are also in the permanent collections of Tate Modern, Saatchi Gallery, Victoria & Albert Museum, Arts Council of Great Britain Collection (all in London), and UBS Funds, Kunsthalle Basel, Switzerland.

彼得·佩里1971年出生於英國倫敦,1994年獲得英國倫敦中央聖馬丁藝術與設計學院設計系榮譽藝術學士。2003年畢業於切爾西藝術與設計學院藝術碩士課程。目前,佩里生活和工作於英國倫敦。

佩里以素描、繪畫和雕塑作為主要表現形式,並發展為三個不同的、獨立發展而又相互交錯的系列作品。他的作品著重呈現線條與體積、具象和抽象之間的張力,對傳統和傳統對現代主義影響的尋問。

他的素描作品由微小的、像頭髮一樣的鉛筆線條累積疊加 而成,使其嚴格的構圖和形象更為迷人和緊實。Peri的紙 本作品描繪了包括羅馬天主教的聖物館、抽象肖像和幾何 圖形等主題,通過奇異的光影效果幻化出建築的結構和體 積感,讓人聯想起形而上學的繪畫。

雕塑作品是將家用紙箱組合按比例放大、以暗色鋼鐵為材料制作而成的設計複製品,並形成紀念碑式的、對抗性的立方體形象。在最初的拼裝和組合中所使用的膠帶圈常常被用來象徵荒誕的、中空的「頭部」。

佩里的單色線條繪畫作品以犀利的斜線網絡為特徵,在黑色和粗糙的噴漆背景上繪出純銀、彩色粉筆和記號筆線條。這些作品似乎在追尋一種帶有神秘色彩的幾何語言——由變幻的線條和形式組成的摩斯密碼——用以描述更為本質的世界。

KOUR POUR

庫爾·珀爾

Kour Pour (b. Exeter, England, 1987) graduated with a BFA from Otis College of Art and Design, Los Angeles, USA in 2010. Pour's practice explores the various aspects of identity formation, the social and cultural constructions of the West and the East and the way in which these constructions have defined our thinking. He currently lives in Los Angeles, USA.

Inspired by an early education in textiles from his Iranian-born father, who owned a carpet shop in the UK during the late 1980s, Pour's early series of carpet paintings, which take months to prepare, are based on designs the artist has researched from exhibitions and auction catalogues. Each design is highly labour-intensive and incorporates a range of techniques, including scrupulous hand painting, silkscreen printing, and applying paint layers with a broomstick, sanding down, and repainting. The pieces are informed by an interest in carpets and their role in the world as an object of craft—people weaving in a community, the history, the patterns, the figures, as well as their status as collectable commodities.

Pour's newest series of work addresses Japonisme, the fascination by Western artists with Japanese art and aesthetics. In his series *Tectonic paintings*, the artist uses the Japanese Ukiyo-e printing process to produce richly layered and coloured abstract paintings. Originally used to make easily reproducible art for the masses, many elements such as pictorial cropping, clean contours, and compositional characteristics have become incorporated into Western art since the Impressionists. The paintings, which at first appear to reference the Western abstract tradition, are actually a translation of earthquake and volcano maps produced by the Japanese Geological Survey and refer to the shifting and overlapping of aesthetic terms with this physical metaphor of transformation.

Among others, Pour's solo exhibitions include *Onnagata* (2016), Feuer/ Mesler, New York, USA; *Samsara* (2015), Depart Foundation, Los Angeles, USA; *Ozymandias* (2014), Ellis King, Dublin, Ireland; and a forthcoming show at The American Academy, Rome, Italy later this year. The artist's group shows include *Painting Show – Part One* (2015), Galerie Rüdiger Schöttle, Munich, Germany; *From Above* (2015), Di Donna, New York, USA; and *The Go Between* (2014), Museo di Capodimonte, Naples, Italy.

庫爾·珀爾(1987年出生於英國艾希特)在2010年 畢業於美國洛杉磯歐狄斯藝術與設計學院並獲得藝術 學士學位。珀爾的藝術實踐試圖探索身份認同的多個 方面,包括東西方社會和文化的結構及其對東西方思 維方式的影響。藝術家現工作和生活於美國洛杉磯。

珀爾來自伊朗的父親在1980年代末的英國經營起地毯商店,藝術家的早期教育也因此而受到紡織業的震為。隨之,他創作了早期的地毯繪畫系列作品。該系列作品需要花費藝術家數月用於準備和研究展覽和賣會目錄中的設計。每一件作品都需要大量勞動力配合和運用不同種類的工藝。細緻的手工繪畫、絲網印刷、使用掃帚逐層上色、打磨再到重新著色,缺過一不可。藝術家試圖藉此系列作品展現他對地毯的興趣,揭示作為手工品的地毯在世界中扮演的角色——社區中編織地毯的人們、它的歷史、它的紋飾、它的圖案以及它作為收藏商品的狀態。

珀爾最新的作品關注日本風格(Japonisme),一種西方藝術家對日本藝術和日本美學的入迷。在珀爾的「構造繪畫」(Tectonic Paintings)系列中,藝術家採用日本浮世繪印刷的方式製作出層次分明的彩色抽象畫。大量原意為便於批量生產的元素被挪用到印象派以後的西方藝術中,例如裁剪的插圖、清晰的輪廓以及構成的特點。這些作品最初是對西方抽象藝術的參考,但實際上是對日本地理學研究中心地震帶和火山帶地圖的轉譯。他將這種物理上的變化比喻成關於變化和重疊的美術用語。

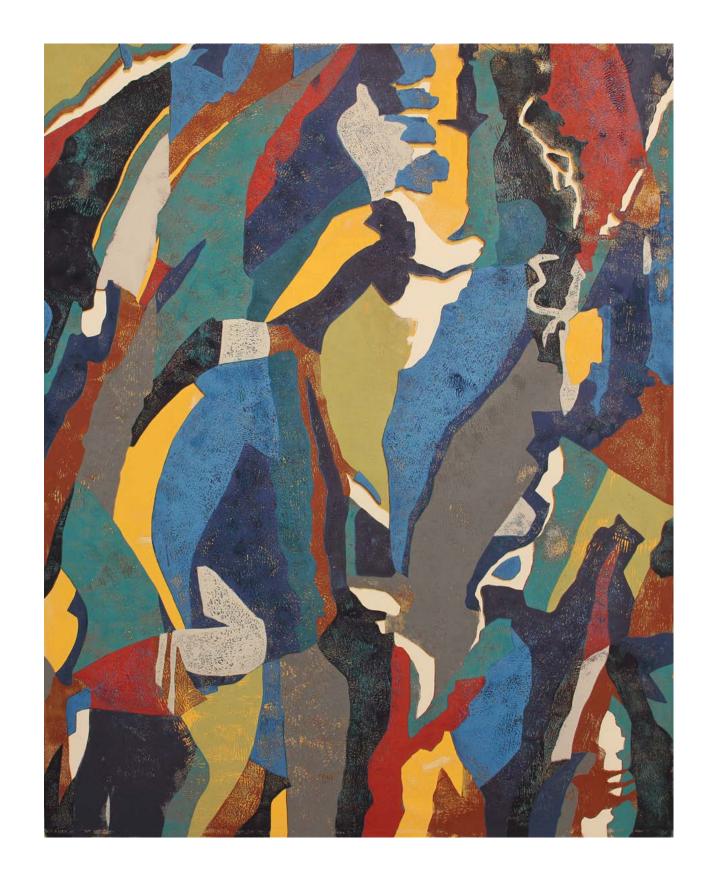

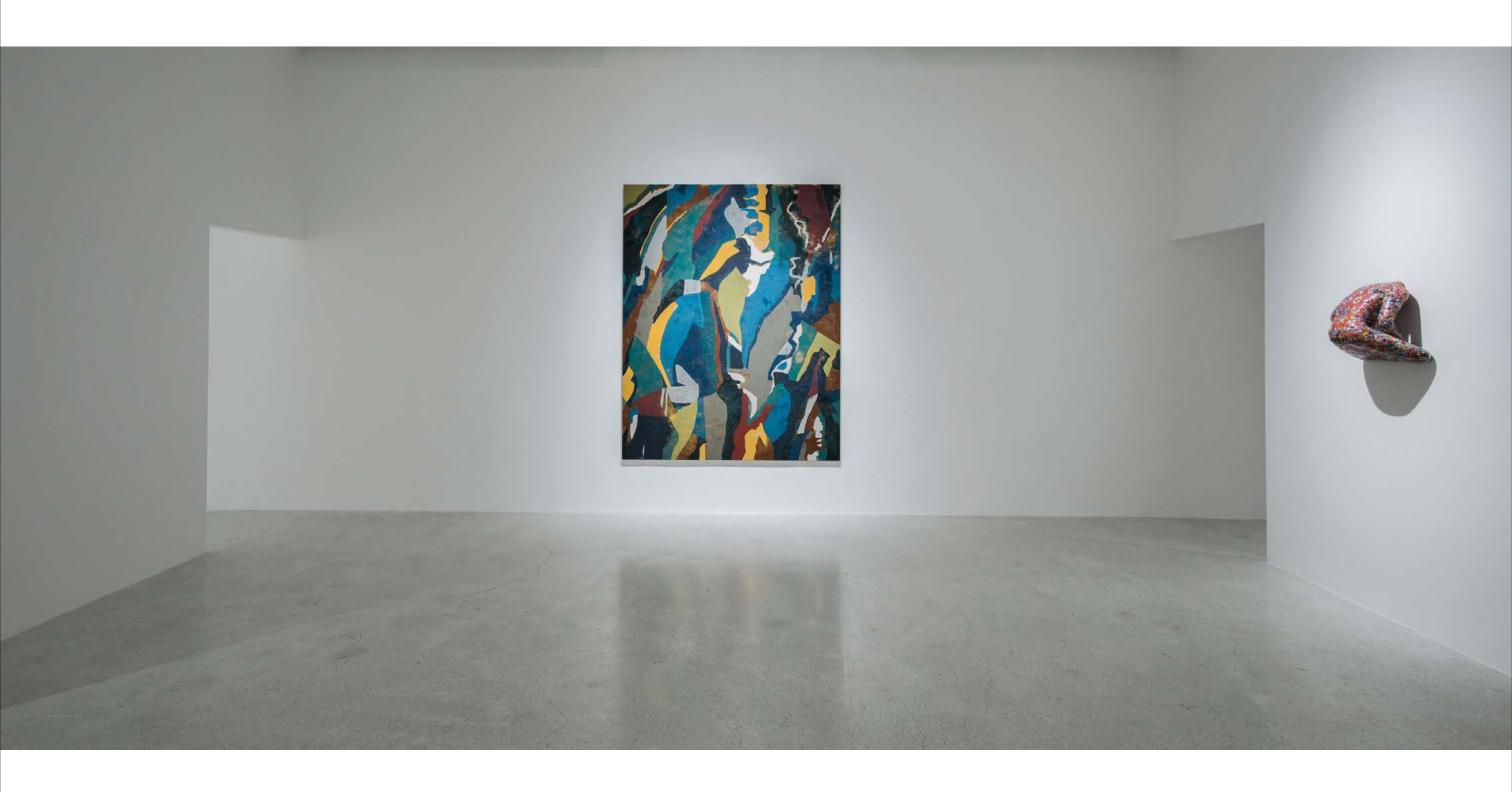

GATOT PUJIARTO 嘉多特・布吉爾多

Gatot Pujiarto was born in 1970 in Malang, East Java, Indonesia. He graduated from the Department of Fine Art and Design at IKIP Malang in 1995. Currently, the artist lives and works in Malang.

Pujiarto's works explore abnormalities, weirdness, and tragedy. Inspired by uncommon events or occurrences in everyday life, including stories heard from friends, TV shows and the news, his works amuse and provoke audiences to reinterpret daily stories as a new reality, to enjoy them through evoking new emotions. The visual sensation in his works is combined with the unique textures that are created by pasting, patching, layering, tearing, binding, and by making fabric patterns.

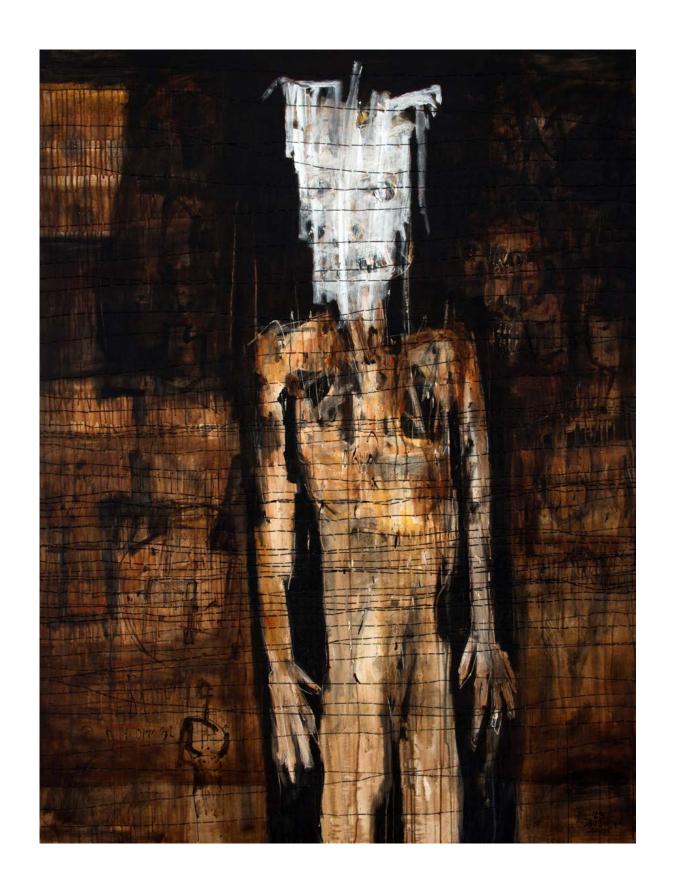
The artist utilises a distinctive collage and weathering technique on fabric, which is either applied on canvas or installed in the form of a tapestry. The bare threads and weave of cloth are revealed for his viewers' scrutiny. The broken cloth acts as a metaphor for the distress of man's action upon nature: negative, confused, and counterproductive to the overarching aim of world harmony. Bare tendrils accumulate to form the skeletal structure of the original cloth, reminding us through nostalgia of what it was originally.

Pujiarto has been widely exhibited throughout Indonesia and internationally. Recent exhibitions include *Stitching Stories* (2016), Pearl Lam Galleries, Hong Kong SOHO; *Masquerade of Life* (2015), Pearl Lam Galleries, Singapore; *Shout—Indonesian Contemporary Art* (2014), Museo d'Arte Contemporanea Roma (MACRO), Rome, Italy; *Indonesian Contemporary Fiber Art* (2012), ArtOne New Museum, Jakarta, Indonesia; and *Jatim Art Now* (2012), National Gallery of Indonesia, Jakarta, Indonesia.

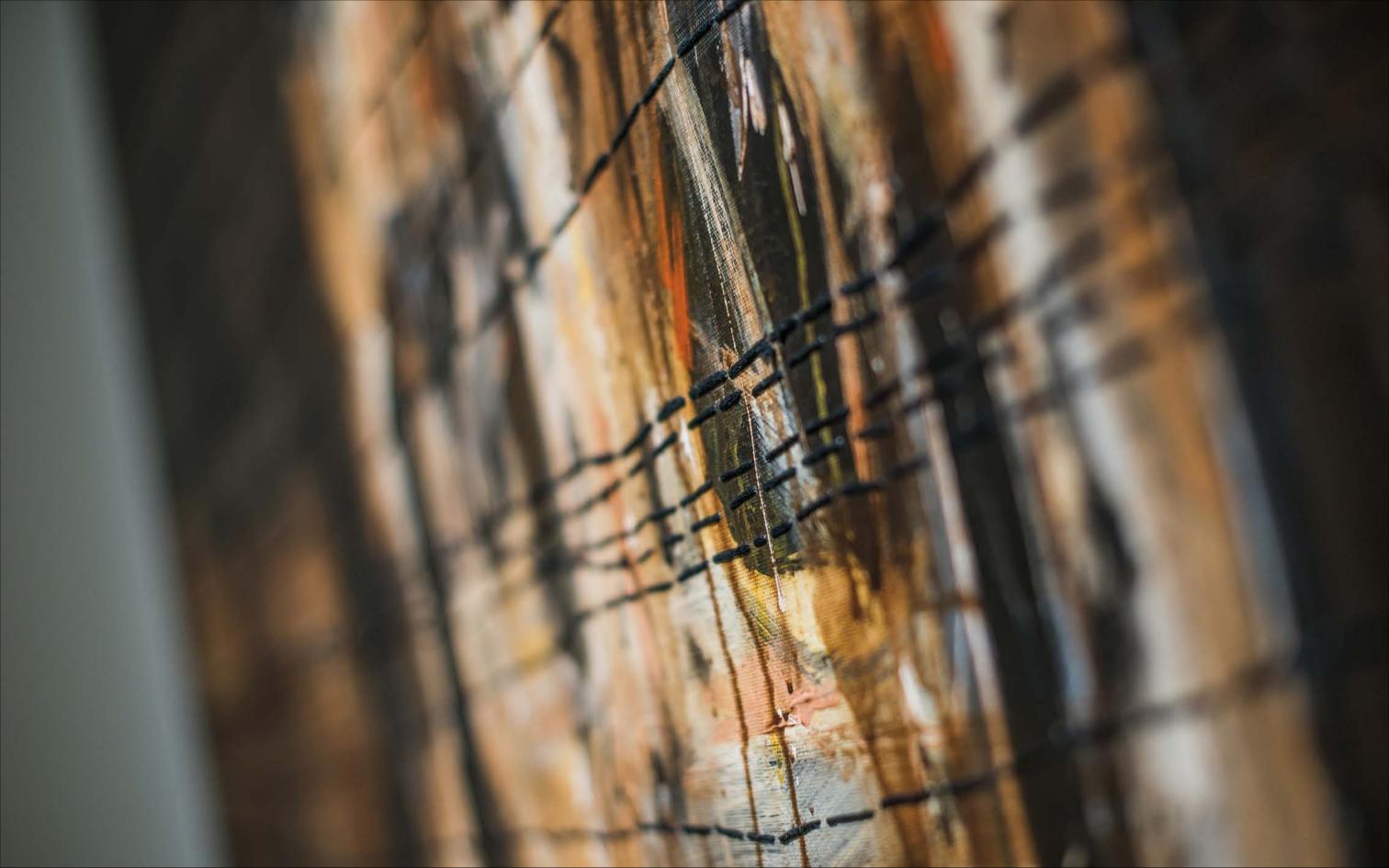

布吉爾使用布料的拼接與磨損技法極為獨特,透過畫布或掛毯形式呈現。過程中刻意 曝露的針腳與線頭,有意識地引導觀者戴著 檢驗的目光去面對作品。一片片的碎布隱喻 著人類對大自然的迫害,當中消極且混亂的 負面能量與自然和諧發展的精神背道而馳。 其中由卷鬚狀的布料構成的作品,隱約可見 布料原始的紋理。

BEN QUILTY

本・奎爾蒂

Ben Quilty was born in Sydney, Australia in 1973. Quilty completed his Bachelor of Visual Arts, majoring in painting at Sydney College of the Arts, University of Sydney in 1994. He later went on to receive a certificate in Aboriginal Culture and History from Monash University in 1996, a Bachelor of Visual Communication at the University of Western Sydney in 2001, and an Honorary Doctorate of Creative Arts at the University of Western Sydney in 2015.

Quilty grew up in the outer suburbs of northwestern Sydney, where he typified the self-destructive characteristics of Australian masculinity: drugs, alcohol, and recklessness. Quilty was a willing participant in this risk-taking and destructive behaviour, but always questioned it. It was this period of his life that inspired most of his work today. Images such as skulls, snakes, and grotesque Siamese-twin compositions have since been seen in his paintings, creating a dark and uncanny genre across the majority of his artworks.

Quilty's painting style can be recognised from his thick layering of paint. He uses different types of palette knives, smearing the paint to create his figures. Quilty does not attempt to hide the strokes from his knife, rather he utilises the thick slabs of paint to block in large areas of the canvas with high contrast colours. He works fast and audiences can see each brushstroke, which gives a three-dimensional appearance and adds another element to his work. His paintings are said to "challenge assumptions" with the bold and unsettling objects which he depicts in his paintings.

Ben Quilty has been widely recognised for his work. Quilty's paintings of his Holden Torana produced a sell-out show in 2002 and since then his work has been seen in many exhibitions and art fairs. Some of his work can be seen at the Art Gallery of New South Wales as well as the Museum of Contemporary Art in Sydney. Quilty won the Doug Moran Portrait Prize in 2009 for his painting *Jimmy Barnes – there but for the grace of God no. 2*. In the same year, Quilty was named runner-up for the Archibald Prize for the same portrait. He then won the Archibald Prize two years later for his portrait of Margaret Olley. In 2014, he received the top award at the inaugural Prudential Eye Awards in Singapore for his painting *Smashed Rorschach*.

His recent solo exhibitions include *The Stain*, Tolarno Galleries Melbourne, Australia (2016); *Straight White Male*, Pearl Lam Galleries, Hong Kong (2015); *Ben Quilty*, Galerie Allen, Paris, France (2014); *Ben Quilty*, Saatchi Gallery, London, UK (2014); *Drawing: Ben Quilty Solo Exhibition*, Tolarno Galleries, Melbourne, Australia (2014); *The Fiji Wedding: Ben Quilty Solo Exhibition*, Tolarno Galleries, Melbourne, Australia (2013); and *My Brothers and Other Paintings: Ben Quilty Solo Exhibition*, Jan Murphy Gallery, Adelaide, Australia (2012).

Other major solo exhibitions include *Critical Impact*, GRANTPIRRIE, Melbourne (2009); *Smashed*, GRANTPIRRIE, Sydney (2008); and *Young and Free?*, Jan Murphy Gallery, Sydney (2004).

本・奎爾蒂在悉尼東北部的郊區長大,他的青年時代是一個典型的自我毀滅性的洲男性形象:毒品、酒精、玩世不恭。他雖然自願參與這些風險性大又具有毀滅性的行為,但同時也對這些行為抱有質疑。正是這段歷史背景賦予了他藝術創作的靈感。在他的大部分作品裏,他塑造了骷髏、蛇和怪誕的連體雙胞胎之類的形象,創造出一種黑暗又神秘的風格。

本·奎爾蒂的繪畫風格以厚實的分層塗料為主,他用不同形式的調色 刀塗抹出他的人物。他從不試圖掩蓋刀痕,他用厚實同時又具有高對 比度顏色的塗料大面積塗抹在畫布上。他下手大膽迅速,觀眾們能從 每寸筆觸中看出三維立體的影像,並因此增加了他作品的元素。他的 繪畫因為其對於大膽而無序的物體的描繪被稱為「挑戰假想」。

本・奎爾蒂的作品已被廣泛認可。自從他畫有Holden Torana車型的作品於2002年被一售而空後,他的作品頻繁出現在眾多展覽和藝術博覽會。部分作品已成為新南威爾士藝術館和當代美術館的固定收藏。Ben Quilty曾以繪畫作品《Jimmy Barnes – There but for the grace of God no. 2》贏得2009年的Doug Moran國家肖像獎。同年,Ben Quilty以同部作品入圍了Archibald獎。兩年後,他以Margaret Olley的畫像贏得了Archibald獎。2014年,他以《Smashed Rorschach》贏得了首屆新加坡Prudential Eye當代亞洲藝術獎。
