New Philip Colbert exhibition 'The Myth of the Lobster Planet' opens

On June 17th 2023, new exhibition *Philip Colbert: The Myth of the Lobster Planet* opens at the Coastal Gallery in the Sea World Culture and Arts Center (SWCAC). Philip Colbert's first exhibition in South China, which is hosted by SWCAC, co-organized by Pearl Lam Galleries and CE.The exhibition is a systematic display of more than 40 representative works of his creative career, including an array of mediums from painting, sculpture, giant installation, video, and furniture design.

A leading figure in the New Pop Art movement, Colbert draws inspiration from the Pop Art movement of the 1960s, reinvents and revitalizes the genre, and his oeuvre weaves together a vibrant amalgamation of artistic idioms, encompassing elements of pop culture, consumerism, historical references, as well as mythological motifs, culminating in a visually captivating fusion known as *Neo Pop Surrealism*.

At the heart of Colbert's artistic practice is an in-depth discussion of contemporary popular culture and its relationship to art history. His works trace back to the classic works in the history of art and pay tribute to the famous masters of classicism, pop art and surrealism. For example, Van Gogh's famous sunflowers, Duchamp's urinals, and Andy Warhol's iconic flowers all appear in the works of this Colbert exhibition, with each art historical guise, the Lobster is reborn into a different time and setting. In this exhibition, Colbert's classic *Functional Sculpture* series will also be displayed, emphasizing his concept that 'art should be everyday, art should be for everyone'. Trying to break through elitism, Colbert seeks to allow more audiences to participate in and appreciate the expression of contemporary art.

The narrative of the exhibition is co-planned by famous critic and researcher Maurizio Bortolotti and the general manager of SWCAC Amber Zhang, in order to reorganize and systematically interpret the artist's works. The space is designed and carried out by COEXIST. Philosopher Nelson Goodman wrote in his book *Ways of Worldmaking*. 'We are not speaking in terms of multiple possible alternatives to a single possible world but of multiple actual worlds'. Colbert constructs a surreal world through art, responding to Goodman's vision of recreating multiple worlds.

SWCAC is honored to present Philip Colbert's first large-scale solo exhibition in South China, through Self-Representation: Painters and Painting Tools, Reconstruction: Classical Art and the Digital Realm, Tribe: Totems and Sculpture and Hunting Theater: Classicism and Planet Recreation. The audience is invited to enter a multi-dimensional and surreal pop art world that transcends the boundaries of traditional art, exploring the artist's creative process through a layered spatial narrative.

The exhibition will be open until October 15th.

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About the artist: Philip Colbert

Philip Colbert (born 1979)

Born in Scotland but living and working in London, Colbert is often referred to as "Andy Warhol's godson". A graduate of the University of St Andrews with a Master's degree in Philosophy, Colbert has gained a worldwide following for his cartoon lobster images and masterful hyper-pop history paintings, championed by major figures in the art world such as Charles Saatchi and Simon de Pury. His work powerfully explores patterns of contemporary digital culture and its relationship to the deeper dialogue of art history.

Inspired by early pop artists such as Richard Hamilton, Roy Lichtenstein, and James Rosenquist, Colbert interweaves pure art themes from old masterpieces and contemporary art theory with everyday symbols of contemporary mass culture, and narrates through the perspective of Colbert's alter ego, the cartoon lobster. His works have been exhibited in major museums including the Times Museum (Chongqing, China, 2021), the Sejong Art Center (Seoul, Korea, 2021), the Yicang Art Museum (Shanghai, China, 2020), Saatchi Gallery (London, UK), 2020) and the Multimedia Art Museum (Moscow, Russia, 2020). Colbert has also collaborated with internationally renowned brands such as Bentley Motors, Rolex, Montblanc, Christian Louboutin, Comme des Garçons and Adidas.
